

To register, go online to www.juniortours.com/go and enter Tour Number: 26CDHYLTON.

You will be directed to a website where you will create an account and begin the process of registering to travel. Follow the prompts to enter your contact information, payment information and agreement to the Terms & Conditions (as outlined on the next page of this form).

Please Note: If an insufficient number of people register to travel with your group, the tour may be cancelled and you will receive a FULL REFUND.





REGISTRATION

- Above is a QR Code you can copy and share to get to the registration page at www.juniortours.co/go.
 - o You will just need your Tour Number.
- Please complete your Registration now. It is NOT necessary that you enter any Billing Information. When you get to that screen, contact your tour coordinator and they will make you a Comp Chaperone and give you access to the Trip Leader Dashboard.
- Additional Comp Chaperones can register at any time. Please email us back once they have created their account and reached the screen asking for their Billing Information. At that time, we can designate them as a Comp Chaperone (same as you). Additionally, they can also be given access to the Trip Leader Dashboard, only if you request it.
- Registration must be made by each individual/family. There must be an adult designated as the Account Holder who initially creates the account and makes the first deposit. Please do NOT try and set up other passengers in your group for them under your account.
- When a passenger registers, they will be asked to provide Billing Information (either credit card or e-check).
 - Once they complete this, they will appear on the 'Confirmed' List on your Group Leader Dashboard. They will have the choice to either 'Pay Now' or exit registration and allow 'AutoPay' to process their full first deposit, plus cost of optional Trip Protection, on the first deposit due date.
 - o If a passenger registers, but does not provide Billing Information, they will appear on the 'Pending' List on your Trip Leader Dashboard. We will not be holding spots for people on this list. They will be emailed at least two reminders to log back in and make a payment. If they don't respond, we may end up moving them from the Pending list to the Cancelled list.
 - If too few people register, the tour can be cancelled, and everyone will receive a full refund.

OPTIONAL TRIP PROTECTION

- Everyone will be given the opportunity to purchase TripMate's Trip Protection Plans.
- STANDARD TRIP PROTECTION PLAN (4.5% of the total trip cost) includes:
 - o 100% Refund of all tour payments (less cost of insurance) if cancelled prior to departure for medical or other qualified reason
